# QUILT DONATION INFORMATION SHEET

Thank you for your interest in the 2020 Eau Claire County Farm Technology Days (FTD) show, an educational exhibition of agriculture and agri-business innovations. Approximately 45,000 people are anticipated to attend the 3-day event. The primary audience is expected to be those with diverse agricultural ties and/or individuals living within 50 miles of Eau Claire. The **July 21-23, 2020** event is being hosted by Huntsinger Farms, Inc./Silver Spring Foods, Inc.

The Family Living Committee's goal is to make the Rural Event Center (REC) tent an inviting destination for individuals from broad backgrounds and interests. This tent will host the opening ceremony on the first day and daily will include a performance stage, arts and craft vendors, educational booths, an information table, a family sanctuary respite area, a quilt display, a photography exhibit and the host farm display.

We are pleased to invite and showcase skilled craftspeople living and working in our area. Below is pertinent information to assist you in making an informed decision about participation.

- Donations must be hand-made quilts of any size, wall hangings, table runners or similar sewing projects; projects from kits are acceptable.
- High quality construction, creativity and visual appeal are important.
- Completed projects must be delivered/mailed to the UW Extension Office located at 227 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Altoona, WI 54720 no later than Friday, **June 26, 2020**. **Clearly label package as "quilt"**. Other arrangements for item pick-up can be made with the quilt coordinator at the contact information below.
- The donor's name (optional) and quilt pattern name (if appropriate) may be included with the donated project. This information may be used in a display or to acknowledge the donor with FTD raffle prize information.
- Please attach a note with the value of the item indicated for the Committee's record keeping purposes.
- As donations are received, photos of the projects may be included on the official FTD web page or incorporated in publicity and marketing venues.
- Projects may be displayed in the Rural Event Center tent during the 3-day event; however, keeping donations clean and protected is of greater concern, therefore an alternate presentation format may be utilized.
- Donated projects will be incorporated with all other FTD donated items and raffled as one event wide venture; quilts will **not** be raffled separately.
